The flyer below was a one page sheet which had the map of my address at the bottom (which I have

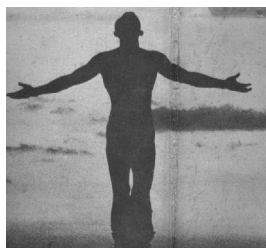
deleted for space purposes). I had felt particularly playful, so I scanned in some photos from the '64 Philippinensian, and threw in a doctored one of myself, too.

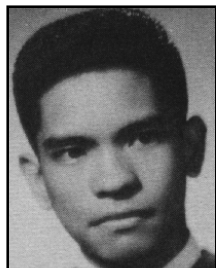
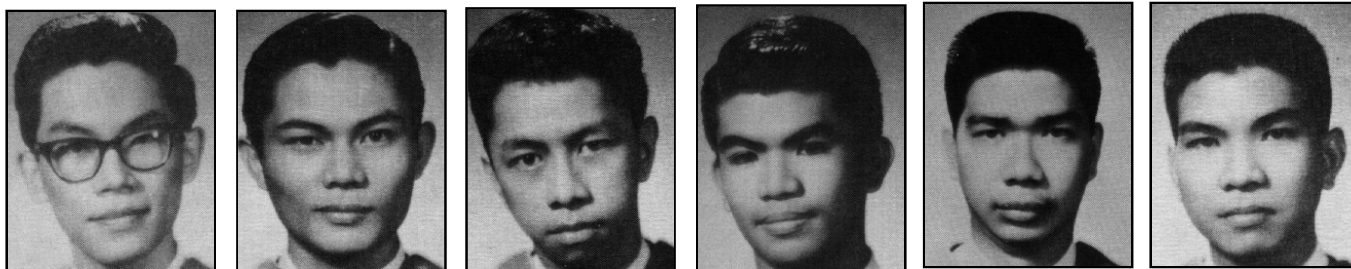

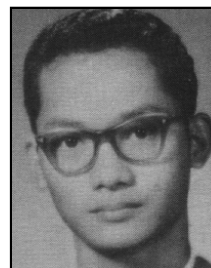
